**Position Summary:** The services of a physician licensed in the State of Mississippi to practice medicine will provide physician services for sites primary in Yazoo and Belzoni or other sites deemed necessary by the CMO. The relationship between the physician and APRN will consistent with Mississippi regulations for midlevel providers. The Physician works with other healthcare team members to provide quality patient-centered care in an integrated healthcare setting.

## **Essential Duties:**

- Provide patient services during time of facility operation as specified in policies and procedures.
- Provide medical direction for the facility's healthcare activities and consultation for, and medical supervision of the clinical staff, in the absence of the CMO.
- Provide primary medical care as evidenced by compliance with the following standards (1) performs medical examinations, procedures and prescribes medications to patients as assigned or needed (2) advises patients on health care education issues when needed (3) effectively and efficiently completes all paperwork requirements for billing and medical records compliance.
- Participate in quality improvement efforts.
- Work cooperatively with the CMO in providing clear medical documentation.
- Work with CMO to facilitate Primary Care Center Facility regulations/policies.
- Maintains professional and congenial attitude toward patients.
- Coordinates with other provider's program that address the unmet healthcare needs of a clinical or educational nature.
- Participate in community outreach events.

- Keep all matters related to the organization, GACFHC and patient, confidential in compliance with confidentiality policy and or HIPPA regulations.
- Other duties as necessary to ensure successful attainment of GACFHC goals and objectives.

**Job Qualifications and Requirements:**

- Degree in Family Medicine from an accredited medical school.
- Licensed to practice medicine in the State of Mississippi.
- Board certification in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine or Meds/Peds.
- Must have and maintain current Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) registration.
- Experience providing medical care, particularly with vulnerable and/or diverse population.
- CPR Certificate.
- Attend/complete CME annually as directed by the State of Mississippi Board of Licensure.
- Ability to work in a team oriented environment.
- Ability to work efficiently in a clinical setting to meet productivity requirements.
- Must embody the mission and vision of GACFHC.
- Must follow appropriate legal and ethical conduct.
- Strong oral and written communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to work with diverse populations.
