Position Summary: The Nurse Practitioner provides professional comprehensive primary medical care to GACFHC patients under the supervision of the Chief Medical Officer. The mid-level provider works with other healthcare team members to provide quality patient-centered care in an integrated healthcare setting.

Essential Duties:

- Obtain history and performs physical examination to determine a diagnosis and treatment plan in accordance with established procedures and policies. Requisitions lab tests, writes prescriptions and makes referrals as deemed appropriate
- Delegate patient care responsibilities that fall under the scope of other healthcare team members to those individuals (nurse, medical assistant, etc....).
- Assesses, treats and manages specific illnesses and conditions according to medical regimens, utilizing established protocols.
- Consults and works collaboratively with physicians and other health care providers to develop effective treatment plans. Provides directions to other personnel and reviews medical records to verify that each patient's care plan and medical needs are being met.
- Other duties as necessary to ensure successful attainment of GACFHC goals and objectives.
